The Fox Without Borders program is a non-credit program open to current Temple graduate students and alumni interested in traveling virtually! Created from the inability to travel, Fox Without Borders provides an opportunity for students to experience another country and its culture from a business, social and cultural perspective without leaving home. Each series will have four sessions and take a highly focused approach to learning about a single country per series. Upon completion, students will receive a Global Business Professional Certificate.

The Fox School and the Center for International Business Education and Research (CIBER) developed this virtual program, recognizing that while most global travel today is restricted, the need to understand the global economy could not be more necessary. Though nothing can replicate the experience of traveling abroad, we have taken every step to provide the benefits of traveling to a country to experience its business environment from an academic and cultural lens without a passport.

SERIES OUTLINE

Session One: Academic Briefing

Session Two: Expert Roundtable

Panel of two or three speakers living in country of focus to discuss their professional, cultural and social experiences

Session Three: Current Event Lecture

Focused discussion of country's economic, business, political, social and cultural landscape led by an expert speaker

Session Four: Cultural Lecture and Debrief

Cultural experience to enhance the cultural immersion/competency and an academic and cultural debrief by Fox faculty
