

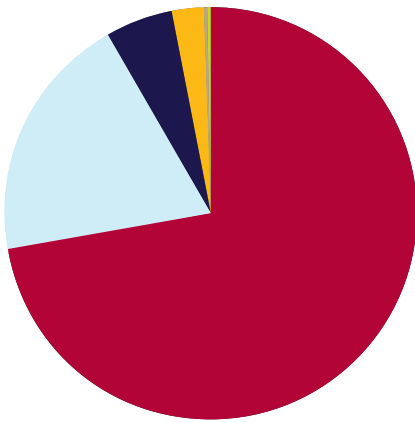
UNDERGRADUATE CAREER OUTCOMES REPORT

92% PLACEMENT RATE

Of the graduates who indicated they were seeking employment*, 92.1% were successfully employed in a full-time, business-related or entrepreneurial career within 6 months of graduation.

The Fox Center for Student Professional Development (CSPD) surveys students and works with academic departments, student organizations and the University Career Center to track post-graduation outcomes. Information is also collected via LinkedIn, official institutional records, and other sources.

TIMING OF EMPLOYMENT



Of the 1064 graduated students that were successfully employed within 6 months, 61.7% secured employment before or at graduation.

DEFINITIONS: These definitions are consistent with the National Association of Colleges and Employers (NACE).

PLACEMENT RATE: Percentage of graduates (of those seeking employment)*, who are working in full-time business-related careers within 6 months of graduation. 92% (N = 1064/1155)

OUTCOMES KNOWLEDGE RATE: Percentage of graduates for which the institution has reasonable information concerning the graduates' post-graduation activities. 80.5% (N = 1241/1541)

SALARY KNOWLEDGE RATE: Percentage of those employed in full-time business-related careers for which the institution has reasonable information concerning the graduates' salary information. 47.6% (N = 506/1064)

CONTINUING EDUCATION: Graduates who are accepted into a program of further study. This includes graduate school or other specialized training.

NO INFORMATION AVAILABLE: Graduates who have not responded to multiple efforts to obtain information about their post-graduation career plans.

***SEEKING EMPLOYMENT:** Graduates who have indicated that they were seeking employment or engaged in the job-search process. 74.9% (N = 1155/1541)

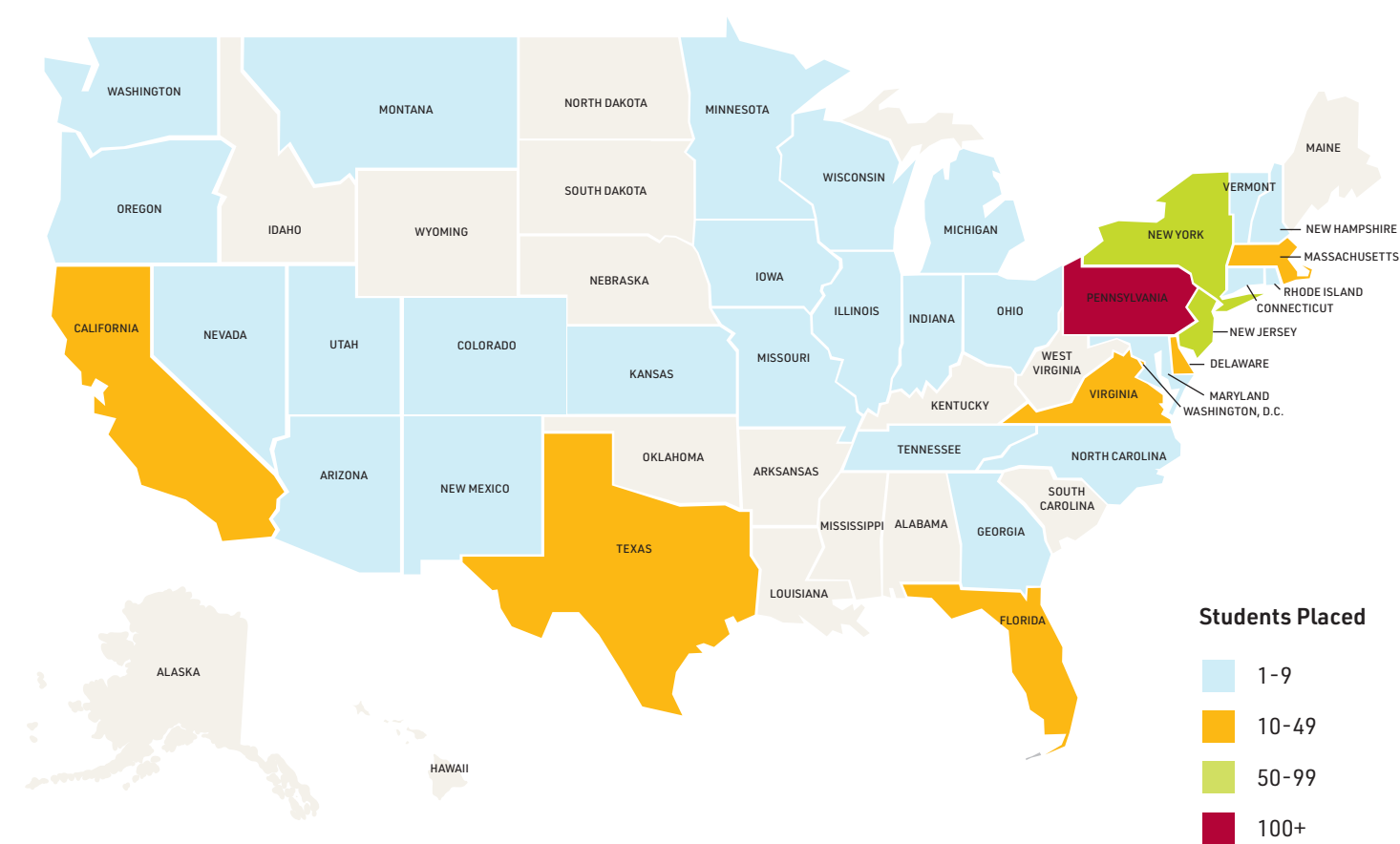

HANDSHAKE

EMPLOYER INTERVIEWS

CSPD hosts numerous employers on-campus and virtually each semester to interview Fox students for internships, co-ops or full-time career opportunities. Students may apply for these interviews through Handshake.

FALL & SPRING CONNECTIONS

Our Fall and Spring Connections are networking events with employers who are recruiting talent for internships, co-ops and full-time post-graduation opportunities.

MOCK INTERVIEWS

CSPD's corporate partners assist with the professional development of our students through their participation in mock interviews. Students not only get to simulate the process through these practice interviews, but they have the opportunity to identify strengths and areas for improvement based on employer feedback.

EMPLOYER RESUME CRITIQUES

The employer resume critique is an opportunity for students to meet with an industry partner and receive one-on-one feedback.

INFORMATION TABLES

Information tables offer students an opportunity to network with representatives from a Fox industry partner in an informal setting. Students gain insight into the job search process as well as learn about organizations and available job opportunities.
