





HANDSHAKE

Our Fall and Spring Connections are networking events with employers who are recruiting talent for internships, co-ops and full-time post-graduation opportunities.

MOCK INTERVIEWS

CSPD's corporate partners assist with the professional development of our students through their participation in mock interviews. Students not only get to simulate the process through these practice interviews, but they have the opportunity to identify strengths and areas for improvement based on employer feedback.





EMPLOYER RESUME CRITIQUES

The employer resume critique is an opportunity for students to meet with an industry partner and receive one-on-one feedback.
